What is Night to Shine?

Night to Shine, sponsored by the Tim Tebow Foundation and hosted by Church on Bayshore, is an unforgettable prom night experience. It is centered on God's love for people with special needs. On one night, February 7, 2025, churches from around the world will host Night to Shine for 115,000 honored guests through the support of 215,000 volunteers!

Where is the event?

Night to Shine will happen at local churches around the world on February 7, 2025. Church on Bayshore is an approved host, located at 622 Bayshore Dr., Niceville, FL 32578

When is the event?

Friday, February 7, 2025 from 6:00 – 9:00 pm.

What is expected?

To attend this event, guests are asked to complete the guest registration and answer all questions required. Guests will receive updates about the event as the event date gets closer.

What will each honored guest experience?

Upon arrival, guests will walk the red carpet, adorned with paparazzi, pom poms, and other people cheering you on as you enter the prom experience. Guests will then check in with their adult, and receive instructions, and name tags.

Each honored guest will be paired with a "Buddy" who has been carefully selected as well as fully background screened and trained. This Buddy will hang out the entire event with the honored guest (unless the guest is bringing their own buddy).

The night is filled with exciting activities to choose from. Activities range from things like dancing, music, karaoke, glam stations, coloring, board games, photo booths, stretch limo rides, dinner, and dessert. To top the night off, a special crowing ceremony will take place where each guest will receive their own crown.

What is the dress code for this event?

This event is formal; attendees must dress in formal attire. For a limited time in the month of January, Church on Bayshore will provide a prom dress shop appointment for guests to choose a prom dress from. These dresses are free of charge. Contact Kelly@churchonbayshore.org for more information.

Does the caregiver need to stay with the Honored guest since he/she will have a buddy?

We ask that caregivers stay onsite during the duration of the event. Caregivers can have their own respite space. In that space, the caregiver will enjoy dinner, some activities, and the opportunity to interact and connect with other Special Needs families and caretakers. If the Honored Guest requires medical care or needs the caregiver to stay with them, that can be arranged. If any medication needs to be administered, the caregiver must be present and administer medication. Night to Shine volunteers are not to administer any medications. Please note that each guest is limited to two caregivers.

What is the minimum age for Night to Shine honored guests?

Night to Shine is for anyone with special needs, ages 14 and older. There is no maximum age.
